By signing below, I acknowledge that I am 18 years of age or older, certify that my dog has a current Rabies Vaccination, and that I have read, understand, and agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth for participation in this event by the City of Frostburg. I understand that I am responsible for the actions of all dogs and minor children that I bring to the Frostburg Dog Splash, and that I may be held liable for any injuries or damages that may arise as a result of their conduct. Furthermore, I agree to hold harmless the City of Frostburg, Friends of the Frostburg Dog Park Fund, the Upper Potomac Valley Kennel Club, their parent organizations, agents, assigns, volunteers, employees and Dog Park Committee Members for any injury or damage to any person, animal, or property that may occur while at the event.

I further agree that the above named shall not be held liable for any costs or expenses incurred in connection with any claim occurring as a result of participation in the Frostburg Dog Splash by me and/or any minor children or dogs brought with me and listed below. I understand that I am responsible for the safety and supervision of any child under the age of 18 y/o that accompanies me to the event.

Finally, I understand this is a Dog Splash, <u>NOT</u> an open swim. If I choose to enter the water, I do so at my own risk. I am aware that the pool may not meet disinfection requirements and water quality standards required by state health department regulations for public swimming pools. I also am aware it is recommended that small children, the elderly, and those with weakened immune systems refrain from entering the water.

* If your dog has had persistent vomiting, diarrhea, coughing, or sneezing within the last 7 days, we ask that your dog not participate. DHPP & Bordetella vaccines are recommended for all dogs participating.

If you or your dog is uncomfortable or over-excited at any time, please watch from a distance with your dog until your dog calms down.



Dog Splash Rules:

- ➤ The Pool Manager & Lifeguards are in charge and <u>must</u> be obeyed at all times.
- ➤ You are responsible for the safety and supervision of any dogs and children you bring! All children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Watch your dog, children, and surroundings carefully.
- ➤ No more than 3 dogs per person over 18 years old.
- Maintain voice control of your dogs and keep your leash handy at all times.
- ➤ It is <u>YOUR RESPONSIBILITY</u> to clean up your dog's waste immediately! If you see a dog taking care of business, please try to locate and notify the owner. Please keep dogs with diarrhea out of the water! *DIARRHEA IN THE WATER REQUIRES US TO CLOSE THE POOL!*
- ➢ If your dog becomes aggressive, uncomfortable, or over-excited at any time, please leash your dog immediately and exit the pool area (outside the fence) until your dog calms down.
- ➢ If your dog has had persistent vomiting, diarrhea, coughing, or sneezing within the last 7 days, we ask that your dog not participate. DHPP & Bordetella vaccines are recommended.

*You are welcome to enter the water with your dog. We will have lifeguards on duty. But, please be aware that this is not a public swim day and the pool may not meet water quality standards required by state health department regulations for disinfection of public swimming pools. ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE WATER, DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. We appreciate your cooperation and assistance with the enforcement of the rules listed above.
